

ORDINANCE NO. 26-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR THE 2023 AVON PARKS MOWING CONTRACT NO. 1 (THE BOARD OF EDUCATION SOCCER FIELD COMPLEX, AQUATIC FACILITY GROUNDS, FIRE STATION SITE, POLICE STATION SITE, AND THE AVON POST OFFICE SITE) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Service Department desires to engage a qualified, dependable and conscientious contractor to perform routine lawnmowing and landscape maintenance activities at various city owned/maintained public open spaces and parks throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, the Avon Service Director and Street Superintendent recommended grouping the public mowing contracts into smaller, separate contracts to allow for more contractors to bid on each project and thereby achieve more competitive pricing, better quality and more responsiveness; and

WHEREAS, with the overall success achieved through the 2022 bidding process, the same format was utilized for 2023 with plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd.; and

WHEREAS, Avon City Council passed Resolution R-7-23 on January 23, 2023 which authorized the public bid for the Avon Parks Mowing Contract No. 1 consisting of the Board of Education Soccer Field complex, Aquatic Facility grounds, Fire Station site, Police Station site, and the Post Office site; and;

WHEREAS, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on February 15, 2023 at Avon City Hall. The responsive bids received are as follows:

WHEREAS, the Engineer's estimate for the project was \$33,828.30 and the low bidder's bid was below the Engineer's estimate of cost. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto as [Exhibit A](#); and

WHEREAS, the Avon Service Director and Street Superintendent reviewed each of the bids submitted and is recommending that the bid submitted by ESK Landscaping to be considered the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the community that the City Administration go forward with the awarding of a mowing contract to ESK Landscaping for the 2023 Avon Parks Mowing Contract No. 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That pursuant to bids received on February 15, 2023 at Avon City Hall for the Avon Parks Mowing Contract No. 1 (The Board of Education Soccer Field Complex, Aquatic Facility grounds, Fire Station site, Police Station site, and the Avon Post Office site), the bid submitted by ESK Landscaping in the amount of Twenty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$29,400.00) is declared to be the lowest and best bid. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the 2023 Avon Parks Mowing Contract No. 1 with that entity. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payments from each of the following funds: 1) Avon Aquatic Facility, Fund No. 255; 2) Park Operating Fund, Fund No. 250; 3) Police Department Fund, Fund No 221; 4) Fire Department Fund, Fund No. 200; and 5) General Fund, Fund No. 100 in amounts totaling the amount set forth herein

Section 2- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3- That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to contract lawnmowing and landscape maintenance service for the 2023 season prior to the start of the growing season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
