

ORDINANCE NO. 30-23

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE PUBLIC BIDS FOR THE 2023 AVON PARKS
MOWING CONTRACT NO. 5 (THE AVON CITY HALL COMPLEX INCLUDING
THE AREA ADJACENT TO THE MIDDLE ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY,
THE NORTHGATE COMMUNITY CENTER SITE, NORTHGATE PARK,
THE OLD COLORADO RIGHT-OF-WAY AT EATON DRIVE, AND THE
CRUSHER STADIUM COMPLEX INCLUDING THE RECREATION LANE
ENTRANCE UP TO STATE ROUTE 611 (COLORADO AVE.)
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Service Department desired to engage a qualified, dependable and conscientious contractor to perform routine lawnmowing and landscape maintenance activities at various city owned/maintained public open spaces and parks throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, the Avon Service Director and Street Superintendent recommended grouping the public mowing contracts into smaller, separate contracts to allow for more contractors to bid on each project and thereby achieve more competitive pricing, better quality and more responsiveness; and

WHEREAS, with the overall success achieved through the 2022 bidding process, the same format was utilized for 2023 with plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd.; and

WHEREAS, Avon City Council passed Resolution R-11-23 on January 23, 2023 which authorized the public bid for said project known as the Avon Parks Mowing Contract No. 5 consisting of the Avon City Hall complex along with the adjacent Middle Road Right-Of-Way, the North Gate Community Center site, Northgate Park, the Old Colorado Right-Of-Way at Eaton Drive, and the Crusher Stadium Complex including the Recreation Lane entrance up to State Route 611-Colorado Ave.; and

WHEREAS, the bids were opened and read aloud at noon on February 15, 2023 at Avon City Hall. The bids received are as follows:

WHEREAS, the Engineer's estimate for the project was \$41,887.07 and the low bidder's bid was below that amount. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto as [Exhibit A](#); and

WHEREAS, the Avon Service Director and Street Superintendent reviewed each of the bids submitted and is recommending that the bid submitted by Brightview Landscape Services to be considered the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the community that the City Administration go forward with the awarding of a mowing contract to Brightview Landscape Services for the 2023 Avon Parks Mowing Contract No. 5.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That pursuant to bids received on February 15, 2023 at Avon City Hall for the Avon Parks Mowing Contract No. 5 (the Avon City Hall complex along with the adjacent Middle Road Right-Of-Way, the North Gate Community Center site, Northgate Park, the Old Colorado Right-Of-Way at Eaton Drive, and the Crusher Stadium Complex including the Recreation Lane entrance up to State Route 611 (Colorado Ave.), the bid submitted by Brightview Landscape Services in the amount of Forty Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Seven and 01/100 Dollars (\$40,287.01) is declared to be the lowest and best bid. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the 2023 Avon Parks Mowing Contract No. 5 with that entity. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payments from each of the following funds: 1) Park Operating Fund, Fund No. 250; 2) Street Department Fund, Fund No. 201; and 3) General Fund, Fund No. 101 to total the amount set forth herein.

Section 2- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3- That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to contract lawnmowing and landscape maintenance service for the 2023 season prior to the start of the growing season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
