

**ORDINANCE NO. 49-23**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A DONATION  
MADE TO THE AVON SENIOR CENTER BY THE VETERANS OF  
FOREIGN WARS OF OHIO CHARITIES, (VFW POST 7035)  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of Ohio Charities (VFW Post 7035), located at 36950 Mills Road, Avon, Ohio desires to make a donation to the City of Avon earmarked specifically for use by the Avon Senior Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Council after considering the recommendation of the Finance Director, deems it desirable and in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the community to authorize the Mayor to accept said funds to be utilized for the benefit of the Avon Senior Center.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Avon, is hereby authorized and directed to accept the donation from the Veterans of Foreign Wars of Ohio Charities, (VFW Post 7035), located at 36950 Mills Road, Avon, Ohio in the amount of Four Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,000.00). Council further authorizes the Finance Director to deposit the donation into the City's Avon Seniors Fund, Fund No. 230 to be utilized for the Avon Senior Center.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to accept a donation from the Veterans of Foreign Wars of Ohio Charities (VFW Post 7035); therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

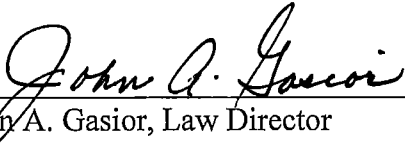

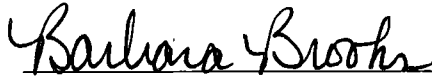
