

**ORDINANCE NO. 80-23**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT APPROPRIATIONS  
ORDINANCE NO. 132-22 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, certain funds within the amount appropriated in Ordinance No. 132-22 do not meet the estimated operational expenses; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That Ordinance No. 132-22 be amended, supplemented and reappropriated as indicated on the attached Exhibit, which is made a part of this Ordinance by reference.

**Section 2.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 3.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity and desirability of establishing a provision of funds for the expenditures for the fiscal year 2023 in order to maintain an efficient City operation; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor.

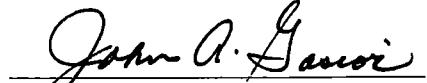

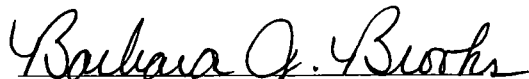

General Fund No 101

Increase Engineering Services by \$100,000 as the original budget is insufficient this year.

Total General fund Re-Appropriations \$100,000.00

Park Operating Fund No 250

Decrease Infrastructure Improvements by \$30,000 as appropriation was included in wrong fund.

Total Park Operating Fund Re-Appropriations (\$30,000.00)

Living Tree Memorial Fund No 253

Increase the amount by \$4,000 to reflect the number of trees being purchased by residents.

Total Living Tree Memorial Fund Re-Appropriations \$4,000.00

Avon Isle Rental Fund No 254

Increase Infrastructures by \$30,000 as it was included in the wrong fund.

Total Avon Isle Rental Fund Re-Appropriation \$30,000.00

2023 Road Program Fund No 421

Increase Engineering \$375,000 and Road Program Improvements \$400,000 as the original budgets are insufficient to complete the improvements.

Total 2023 Road Program Fund Re-Appropriations \$775,000.00

Chester Road/American Way Improvements Fund No 486

Increase Chester Road/American Way Capital Projects by \$750,000 as to include the entire cost of the project.

Total Chester Road/American Way Re-Appropriations \$750,000.00
